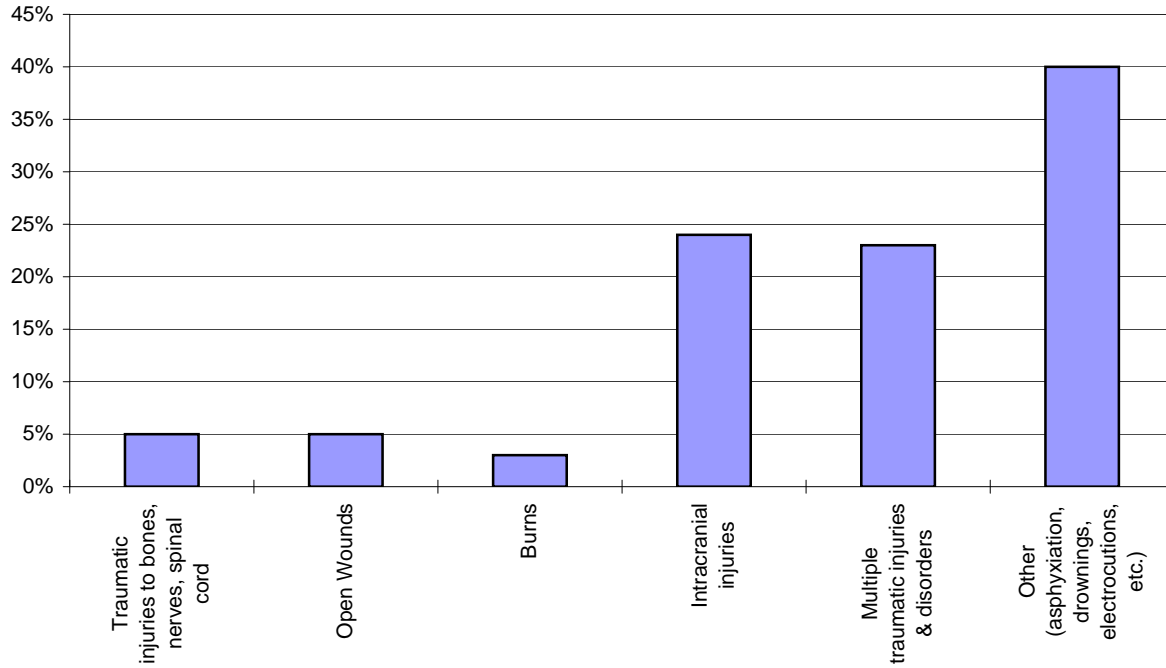
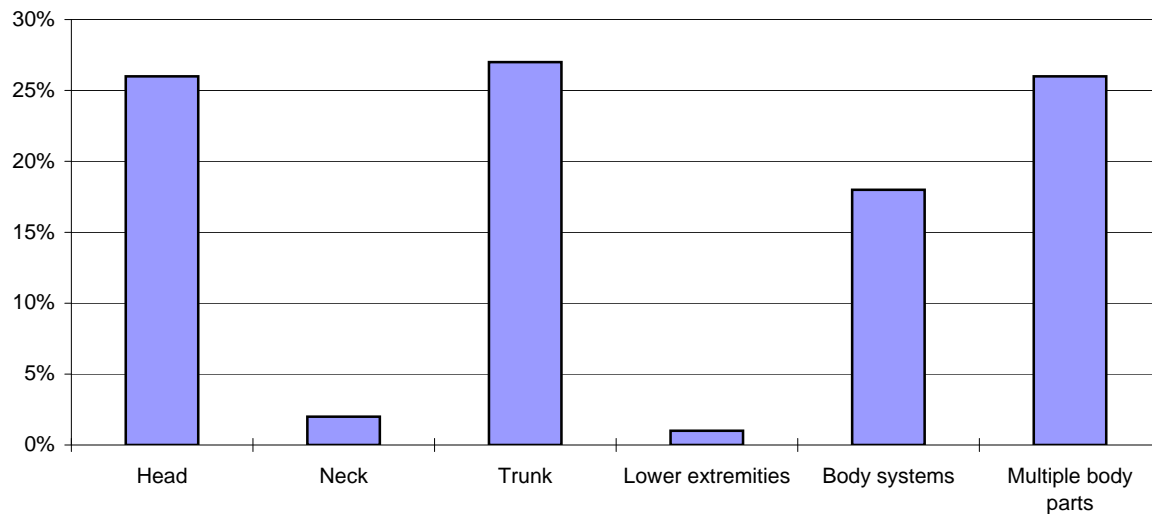


Fatal Injuries by Nature of Injury Wisconsin 1997



Intracranial injuries increased by 4% from 1996 while Other (asphyxiation, suffocations, drownings, electrocutions, etc) decreased by 4%.

Fatal Injuries by Part of Body Wisconsin 1997



Head injuries and multiple body parts both resulted in 26% of Wisconsin fatalities which is a 6% increase from '96. Body systems injuries decreased by 5%.
