

Description of the WCLN Listserv

What is the wcln listserv?

The wcln listserv is an e-mail discussion group or "listserv" which is maintained by Wisconsin State Laboratory of Hygiene staff to serve the clinical microbiology laboratory community in Wisconsin. Only WSLH staff have access to the listserv's member list.

This discussion group is intended for individuals who work in or have an interest in clinical microbiology and infectious diseases, including laboratorians, healthcare providers, infection prevention practitioners, public health workers, etc.

This discussion list is intended to be a resource to improve communication among Wisconsin clinical microbiology laboratory professionals. It provides a forum to discuss laboratory problems, share ideas and best practices, and ask questions about laboratory-related issues.

Format of the wcln listserv

The wcln listserv is an "unmoderated discussion group", which means that messages are not screened, but are sent automatically to all members. WSLH does not actively monitor the site for inappropriate postings, and does not take editorial control of postings.
