

# **Program**

This one-day meeting presented by the Wisconsin State Laboratory of Hygiene (WSLH) offers clinical and public health laboratorians, infection preventionists and local health officers the chance to strengthen their relationships through networking and discussions of relevant laboratory issues.

This year's meeting is a continuation of our 3 year plan focused on improving laboratory biosafety and biosecurity in WI.
